3. Purposes and Legal Basis of Data Processing

The legal basis for processing your personal data is Article 6(1)(e) and (f) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation):

1. Performance of a public task by the university, specifically promoting the achievements of science and culture during the conference and acting for the benefit of local and regional communities (Article 11(1)(9) and (10) of the Act of 20 July 2018 on Higher Education and Science).

Providing personal data is necessary for the registration and organization of the conference. Failure to provide data will make it impossible to achieve this purpose.

2. Legitimate interest pursued by the university or a third party, including using and disseminating images as background detail, not the main subject of photos and recordings (e.g., showing the event's occurrence rather than focusing on individual participants). For public figures, this includes informational and promotional purposes (Article 81(2)(2) of the Act of 4 February 1994 on Copyright and Related Rights).

4. Personal Data Retention Period

We will store your personal data as long as necessary to achieve the stated purposes, but no longer than the end of 2026, i.e., until the next edition of the conference.

5. Data Recipients

Your data may be shared with entities processing it on our behalf and entities authorized to receive it under applicable laws.

6. Rights Related to Personal Data Processing

You have the following rights regarding the processing of your personal data:

1) Right to access your personal data.

- 2) Right to request rectification of incorrect or incomplete personal data.
- 3) Right to request deletion of your personal data, particularly if you withdraw your consent and there is no other legal basis for processing.
- 4) Right to request restriction of personal data processing.
- 5) Right to object to processing your personal data due to your particular situation, when processing is based on our legitimate interest, including direct marketing or the performance of a public task. Note: You may object at any time for direct marketing purposes, regardless of your specific situation. Right not to be subject to solely automated decision-making, including profiling.
- 6) Right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority responsible for data protection, i.e., the President of the Personal Data Protection Office.
